Exactly three years ago we said goodbye in style with Donato Dozzy's closing set at the fourth edition of Paral-lel. A lot has happened since then, and surely no one could have imagined that a global pandemic would force us to take this break, but we're back with more enthusiasm than ever.

It's been a difficult few years for the scene, not only for festivals like ours, but also for many artists, labels, and collectives that have been affected by Covid-19. Many projects and ideas have unfortunately fallen by the wayside, so we would like to express our most humble recognition to all of these and also our condolences to all the people who have lost any loved ones during this time.

After this period (from which we should surely also draw many positive lessons), it's time to celebrate life again in the way we like best: listening to music we are passionate about and dancing with all of you at our annual summer gathering in the mountains. We have missed you a lot.

On our fifth anniversary of the festival, we will have a new location. We are 1700 metres above sea level, with more forest areas and spectacular views that will accompany us for three days including 35 hours of music divided into our usual three blocks: prologue (Friday), history (Saturday), and epilogue (Sunday). In addition, on Saturday and Sunday mornings you will have the opportunity to participate in our two professional Paral-lel Plus+ workshops.

We the organisers have worked hard to make your experience as pleasant as possible. You will have at your disposal water to refresh yourselves, more shower modules, and we will offer several food trucks with different food options as well as fruit at the bars of the festival. This year we have increased the number of shuttle buses from Barcelona to minimise the environmental impact of travel, we continue to apply the green tax for all private vehicles travelling to the festival, and we also have more glamping tents available for your comfort.

Respect for the environment and for the neighbours who welcome us has always been one of our priorities. Once again this year, we ask for your utmost attention in reading the list of recommendations in this document, and we remind you that Paral-lel is held in an area declared as a forest zone and that it is forbidden to make any kind of fire on the festival site.

Everything must be left as it was when the festival ends. Use common sense and don't stop enjoying yourselves, the occasion is worth it.

RECOMMENDATIONS



Do not build a fire or cook to prevent forest fire.



Bringing in glass bottles or containers is forbidden.



Camp only in the designated areas.



Know the exact location of the closest fire extinguishers.



Do not throw cigarette butts into the floor. Use your portable ashtray and empty it in the garbage collection points.



Deposit any garbage or waste in designated bins or containers only.



Alcoholic beverages from outside are not allowed into the festival area.



We will charge a deposit of 2 € per reusable glass, which will be refunded when you return the glass to the tickets sales point.



Respect other festival-goers after the performances come to a close.



Respect one another and always treat others as you would like to be treated.



Danger: do not touch the electric fences.



It can get cold at night as you are in the high mountains. Bring warm clothes including a rain jacket, and don't forget SPF for the daytime.



The grounds need to be completely empty by Monday at 11 am at the absolute latest. Go to the meeting point 15 minutes earlier before depart to catch one of our buses: Sunday (9 pm) / Monday (9 am, 10 am and 11 am).



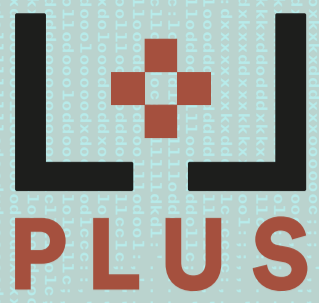
Use your garbage bag to store all waste and leave it in the designated containers before leaving. If you need more waste disposal materials, please ask at the Info Point.
